The Resurrection of Jesus^{NC}

A new historiographical approach

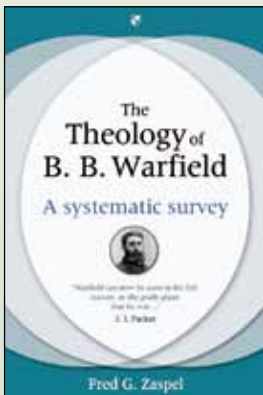

The question of the historicity of Jesus' resurrection has been repeatedly probed, investigated and debated. Perhaps some now regard this issue as the burned-over district of New Testament scholarship. However, Michael Licona convincingly points us to a significant deficiency in approaching this question: our historiographical orientation and practice. So he opens this study with an extensive consideration of historiography and the particular problem of investigating claims of miracles. He then carefully applies his principles and methods to the question of Jesus' resurrection. In addition to determining and working from the most reliable sources and bedrock historical evidence, Licona critically weighs other prominent hypotheses. His own argument is a challenging and closely argued case for the historicity of the resurrection of Jesus, the Christ. Any future approaches to dealing with this 'prize puzzle' of New Testament study will need to be routed through *The Resurrection of Jesus*.

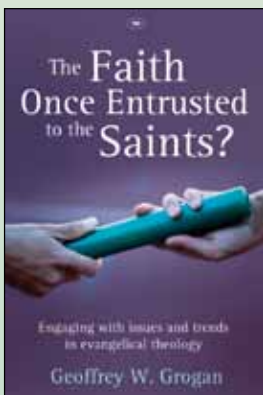
Benjamin Breckinridge Warfield (1851–1921) was undoubtedly one of the greatest Reformed theologians in the history of America. He wrote extensively in defence of fundamental Christian doctrines. While his writing touched on the full spectrum of theological topics, it was spread over hundreds of periodicals, books and pamphlets, and a significant portion has never been published in an accessible form. So Warfield stands as a dominant figure on the theological landscape, but few have a comprehensive grasp of his theology.

Fred G. Zaspel has spent many years studying Warfield's published and unpublished writings, and presents them here in summary as a concise and coherent systematic theology. For the first time ever, readers can, in one volume, access the content of this great theologian's academic, sermonic and devotional works.

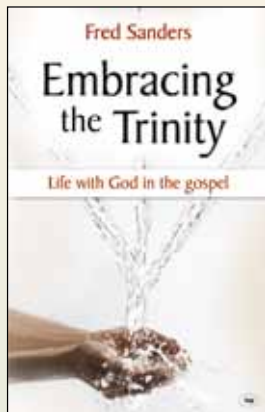

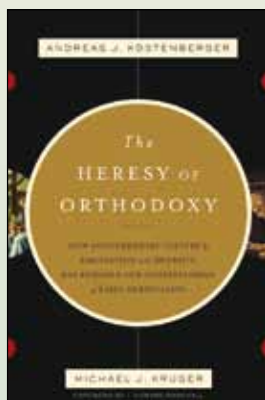

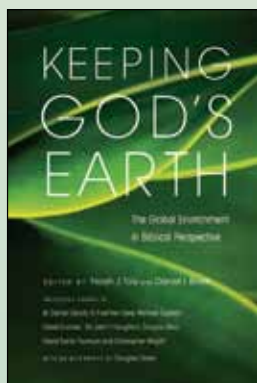
Beginning with Walter Bauer in 1934, the denial of clear orthodoxy in early Christianity has shaped and largely defined modern New Testament criticism, recently given new life through the work of spokesmen like Bart Ehrman. Spreading from academia into mainstream media, the suggestion that diversity of doctrine in the early church led to many competing orthodoxies is indicative of today's postmodern relativism.

Köstenberger and Kruger's accessible and careful scholarship not only counters the 'Bauer Thesis' using its own terms, but also engages overlooked evidence from the New Testament. Their conclusions are drawn from analysis of the evidence of unity in the New Testament, the formation and closing of the canon, and the methodology and integrity of the recording and distribution of religious texts within the early church.
